English Studies in Latin America (ESLA): A Journal of Cultural and Literary Criticism is a double-blind peer reviewed e-journal published by the Department of Literature, at the Faculty of Letters, Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile.* We review academic articles that consider cultural productions in English (past and present), particularly ones that reflect readings *from* Latin America about those productions. We welcome the following critical approaches: comparative and intersectional border studies, postcolonial studies, cultural and gender studies, bilingualism and translation studies.

The language of publication is primarily English, but Spanish contributions may be included if they fit within the journal's scope. Critical articles should have approximately 8,000 words. *ESLA* also accepts poetry, short stories as well as reviews, interviews and essays.

Submissions are accepted throughout the year but the deadline for the upcoming issue is **May 1, 2018**.
